

SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

Mac PC with DVD player using Safari or Firefox web browsers and Flash Media player installed on your PC to hear the audio and see the video. You will also need the free Adobe Reader to open lecture handouts and the self-assessment practice examination. Put the DVD in your PC DVD Player. The AmenuDisc.htm (web page)file should be in the file and folder list for the DVD. Open this file to see all the links on the DVD.
